Key Learning Areas

At Granville Public School, students engage with science and history experiences with their class teacher.

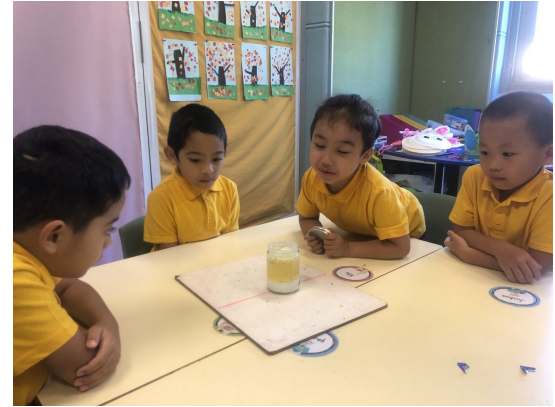
Students also attend PE, creative arts and library lessons once a week with specialist teachers. These lessons are designed to extend students' knowledge in other key learning areas.

Science and History

As part of our teaching and learning strategy, students explore other key strands, such as science and history. Literacy and numeracy skills are integrated into these learning programs.

In science, kindergarten students used hands on experiences to explore topics including the weather and the farm.

In history, the students enjoyed extending their knowledge about their families and exploring Indigenous perspectives through differentiated activities.





Creative Arts

In music, students sing, play and move to a range of music. They experiment with sounds and begin to organise them into basic structures. Students listen and respond to a variety of music.

In visual arts, students make pictures and other artworks using the media and materials given, representing both real and imagined situations. They appreciate that artists make artworks and they begin to describe some aspects of artworks.



PE - Sport

Students develop and practise movement skills and sequences through active play and structured movement activities. Students learn about their strengths and identify actions they can take to keep themselves and others safe when participating in physical activity.



Library

Every week, students have the opportunity to borrow a book from the library to take home and enjoy. During library lessons, students enjoy listening to different stories read by our librarian.
