Dear Parents.

Welcome back to school for another busy and exciting term. A very warm welcome also to families who are new to our school. We hope that your time with the Granville Public School (GPS) community is a happy and productive one.

Not only was this event enjoyed enormously by all who participated and visited on the day, an amount of over \$4,000 was raised for our air conditioning project. Well done everyone.

Today, our dance group is auditioning for a place in the "Our Spectacular' concert which will be held at the Opera House next term. The girls and boys in the dance group have worked very hard to fine tune their routine and we wish them all the very best for the audition.

#### Lesson Study - Professional Learning for Teachers

Teachers at Granville Public School are participating in lesson study over the next two terms. Lesson study involves:

- teachers working in teams to design the best lessons possible for children's learning
- \* watching the lessons being taught
- considering afterwards how the lessons could be improved
- \* re-teaching the improved lesson

We are working together to design great mathematics lessons that include "Critical and Creative Thinking", an aspect of the new Australian Curriculum.

Lesson study means your child's teacher will be off class for half a day once or twice per term. Stages 2 and 3 were off last week for planning and are off this Thursday for lesson observation and discussion. Stage 1 and Early Stage 1 teachers will be off class for half a day the next two Mondays (weeks 3 and 4).

Lesson study is one way to help give a quality education to all children at Granville Public School.

#### Cooking with Ms Denny is awesome!


